Jim Hooker Outstanding Advisor Award Recipients

The Jim Hooker Outstanding Advisor Award is an earned Award granted to advisors of ACJA-LAE in recognition of outstanding service to a chapter and/or region of ACJA-LAE. The Award is granted upon the favorable vote of a majority of the voting membership of ACJA-LAE present at the National Conference and voting is by secret ballot.

The minimum criteria for nomination for the Jim Hooker Outstanding Advisor Award shall be membership in the Association; at least five (5) years continuous service to at least one ACJA-LAE chapter; and attendance with said chapter(s) at the National Conference during the period. Nominations may be submitted by any member in good standing by filling out the Jim Hooker Outstanding Advisor Award Nomination Form and mailing the Form to the National Office by December 31st of each year.
